Deep red purple; fine nose with black fruits, cassis and blackberries. To the mouth, we have soft tannins giving elegance and purity.



SOIL

Clay



GRAPE VARIETIES

Merlot and Cabernet Franc



WINEMAKING

Fermentation and maceration at controlled temperature to avoid the use of CO2. 80% of the tank selected to become the CADET is aged for 18 months in French barrels; the rest with wood staves.



ALCOHOL

14% alc.

2nd wine of Château La Claymore, in French language the "CADET" is the last son, the youngest of the Family. The average age of the vineyards used to this wine is less than 12 years and its ageing is shorter as well, to balance the structure.
